- During the month of October we have parent- teacher conferences. Our teachers review the grade level curriculum, report on progress, and answer any questions.

- Our MTSS Team (Multi-Tiered-Systems of Support) provides an ideal support, utilizing a flow chart which defines the strategies and interventions used, by providing a tiered system of support. The team includes teachers, principal, Reading Intervention teacher, Student Support Specialist, school counselor, and other support staff.
- Throughout the school year our goal is to create a safe, supportive learning environment based on a foundation of trust, clear and consistent communication between staff, students, and families.
